

## Data Set: Canadian Election Study, 2011, Voter Turnout

*Data File:* CES2011-turnout.txt

*Source:* Extract from data set distributed by the Institute for Social Research, York University

*Variables:*

household Household ID number.

province Province code (NL, PE, NS, NB, QC, ON, MB, SK, AB, BC); provinces were used as strata in the sampling design.

population Population of the respondent's province, number over age 17.

weight Weight sample to size of population, taking into account unequal sampling probabilities by province and household size.

education Respondent's level of education: lessHS, HS, somePS, college, bachelors, higher.

gender Female or Male.

age Age in years.

income Respondent's family income, in \$1000s, categorized as <30, 30-59, 60-89, 90-109, 110+. This variable was constructed from reported income in 1000s and reported categorized income. The latter question was asked if the respondent failed to answer the former question.

voted Self-report of voting: Yes or No.

*Note:* There are missing values in this data set, including due to panel attrition, coded as NA.
