

Credit for SHSM graduates now available!

The Faculty of Social Sciences has created a new advanced credit program for students enrolling in Fall 2019 and onwards.

This advanced credit recognizes the completion of specific SHSM programs.

Eligible students can receive advanced credit for one 3 unit course.

Pathways into the Social Sciences (SOCSCI 1HS3) recognizes a set of specialized and transferable skills acquired by students in their SHSM program that facilitates and enhances their transition into a Social Sciences program.

The student receives this course credit at no cost, saving at least \$640 as they will have one less course to take towards degree completion.

How can students receive the credit?

1. Complete an eligible SHSM program.
2. Obtain a minimum 82% final admission average on their 6 U/M courses assessed for program entrance.
3. Enroll in Social Sciences I, Economics I or Health and Society I.
4. Provide their final transcript with completed SHSM credit form (including a report/reflection on what they have learned from completing the SHSM program and how their learning will serve them while enrolled in a Social Sciences program) to the Office of the Associate Dean.
